Robert Dale Wallace, resident of Augusta, died suddenly on Saturday, July 7, 2007. He was 76 years of age.

Mr. Wallace was born July 28, 1930 in Worden, Arkansas a son of the late Milt and Wave Radcliffe Wallace. Mr. Wallace was married to the former Myrtle Grayson for 54 years. He was a charter member of the Baptist Tabernacle Church in Searcy where he served as deacon. He served in the Air Force as a Staff Sargent at Wichita Falls, Texas.
