Ronald Keith Mason, 73, of Judsonia, died Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at home. He was born February 13, 1948 in Searcy to the late Kenneth Mason and Inda (Parks) Bell.

He was raised in Des Arc, Arkansas from a young age. At the age of 14 he began Military School in Colombia, Tennessee. After graduation he enlisted in the United States Navy, where he became an electrical technician. After leaving the navy he returned to Arkansas and worked for the VA in the sign department. He loved music and his passion was the drums. He played music all over Arkansas in several bands and ended up in a Christian Band; he had also played at Sturgis. At the age of 4 his grandmother, Grace Mason started taking him to church and he spent 14 years as the drummer for the Dripping Springs Assembly of God and he was a lifelong member there.
