Ronald "Ronnie" Poe 78 of Searcy passed away Saturday August 10, 2019 after a long battle with Parkinson's. He was born October 31, 1940 in the Mt. Pisgah Community to the late V.C. "Cap" and Helen Poe. He worked most of his life in the timber industry with his father and two brothers. He had a vast knowledge about logging and mechanics. This knowledge gained from his father was skillfully used and passed on to his son, grandson and friends that would come to him with questions.
