Sammie James Smith, 89, of Searcy, passed away Wednesday, February 6, 2019, at his home with his wife by his side. Sammie was born December 21, 1929 in Mt. Pisgah, the son of Elvis Claude and Lena Mable Baughn Smith. Sammie graduated from Pangburn High School in 1948. Sammie was a member of the National Guard for six years and helped with the cleanup of the Judsonia tornado in March 1952. Sammie was employed at Samuel Bingham's for over 38 years. Sammie loved his family and working outside on the farm. He was a member of Mt. Pisgah Missionary Baptist Church for over 75 years.
