Sharon Kay Isham, 81, of Searcy, Arkansas, went to be with the Lord on February 5, 2026. She was born on March 31, 1944, in Searcy to the late Myrl and Bera (Thomason) Sammons.

Following retirement, she felt called to continue serving others and worked with the White County Area Agency on Aging, helping those who could no longer care for themselves. Even as her own health declined, Sharon continued to show compassion and encouragement to those around her. While residing in assisted living, she remained a source of comfort to others. The staff at StoneBridge Senior Living in Cabot affectionately referred to her as their “Bright Light,” a reflection of her sweet smile and caring heart.

Sharon was an avid reader and never met a book she didn’t enjoy, but her favorite book was always the Bible. She kept it close, read it often, and believed wholeheartedly in the promise of eternal life found within its pages. One of her favorite verses was Jeremiah 29:11: “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” One of her most beloved hymns was “How Great Thou Art,” a song that reflected the faith and worship that filled her life. There is no doubt that when Sharon took her final breath on earth, she took her first breath in heaven.
