After Stella and Tommy moved their family to Texas, later on we would plan exciting trips (mainly over holiday weekends) to go visit them. They loved friends and family gatherings so much. When Stella and Tommy moved back to Arkansas it became a ritual that we would alternate New Years and Super Bowl events at each other's homes. We went on a cruise together, and also would plan camping, fishing trips and mini vacations. Stella was a great planner and we had some wonderful times and fond memories. Their health started to deteriorate as we all got older and we lost Tommy on 10/31/2021. Stella lost the love of her life, soulmate and very best friend, and had been mourning over the loss of Tommy nearly all of 2022. We had many long conversations, where my role switched to trying to be a mentor to her. She had decided she was going to try and get her health issues under control best she could. We talked about planning a girls outing trip in 2023. In November prior to her 72nd birthday Stella came down with the flu which later turned into bacterial pneumonia. On top of that she had fallen and broken her right wrist which required surgery but doctor's needed to get her breathing and pneumonia under control enough to perform the surgery. I stayed with Stella on day of her planned wrist surgery (Sunday, 12/11/22) in which surgery went fine but she was still not out of the woods yet with her breathing and pneumonia. She wanted out of the hospital so bad and finally was released on Sunday afternoon, 12/18/22, to go home with Kerry and Marilou Snellgrove to recover. God had other plans for Stella and called her to his heavenly home in the early hours of December 20, 2022. She is no longer suffering in her physical body but is with our glorious God, her husband and all her friends and family that went home before her. Thank you so much Kerry and Marilou for being there with her when she entered the kingdom of heaven. Stella, I love you, I miss you, we all miss you and I will see you again one day.
