Todd Lockhart Brannon, 55, of Augusta, passed away surrounded by his family on Tuesday, June 25, 2019. Todd was the youngest son of Edna Lockhart Brannon and Bob Brannon, Sr. He worked in all areas of his family's towboat and barge business for most of his life and also worked as a commercial diver and welder. He married the love of his life, Leah Collins Brannon on February 14, 1987. They were married for 32 years and had one daughter, Lynlee Brannon Wilkins (Cory) of Paragould. He loved hunting, fishing, playing the guitar and most of all being "Big Daddy" to his grandson Greydon.

Todd was a 32nd degree Mason of Colony Lodge 190 in McCrory, Arkansas where he served as past master. He was also a member of Bendemeer Grotto, the Knights Templar of Arkansas and was also a 32nd degree Mason of the Scottish Rite of Jonesboro. He was awarded the Pillar of Solomon as well as the Arkansas Diamond.

He is survived by his wife, Leah Collins Brannon; daughter, Lynlee Brannon Wilkins (Cory) and a precious grandson, Greydon Everett Wilkins.
