December 27, 1941 - January 18, 2018

Travis Walker Brock, 76, of Searcy, died Thursday, January 18, 2018 at his home. He was born December 27, 1941 in Pangburn to the late Samuel Walker and Ima D. Horten Brock. Travis retired from the United States Army as a Drill Sargent First Class, after 25 years of service. He served 1 tour of duty in Korea and 2 tours in Vietnam and was the recipient of 3 Purple Hearts. He was also awarded 4 meritorious service medals and earned 3 National Defense Service Medals, his Combat Infantry Badge and Expert Infantry Badge.

He served with the Sheriff's Office in Pulaski County Missouri for 12 years and, upon his return to Arkansas, as an Auxiliary Deputy in White County. Travis was a member of the Masonic Lodge #483 in Pangburn, still a standing member of the Waynesville, Missouri Lodge # 375 and a member of the Order of the Eastern Star. He was retired from Brock Excavation, loved horses, hunting and fishing.
