William Henry Lendermon, 82, of Searcy, formerly of West Memphis, died Wednesday, February 4, 2009. He was born August 10, 1926, the son of D. L. and Coma Price Lendermon and his step-mother, Vellia Parks.

Mr. Lendermon served in the United States Navy aboard the USS Wake Island. He served in the South Pacific and was involved with the invasion of the Phillipine Islands, Iwo Jima, and Okinawa.

He graduated with honors from the University of Arkansas with a degree in Agriculture. He has worked as a county agent, Loan Officer, Branch Manager of the West Memphis and Forrest City PCA office, Vice President and President of the Lonoke Production Credit Association, finishing his career with the Small Business Administration as an Agriculture Loan Specialist, where he was an "employee of the year." He was an avid golfer and was ordained a deacon at Calvary Baptist Church in West Memphis, where he served for 26 years. He was a member of Valley Baptist Church of Searcy for 22 years.

Mr. Lendermon is survived by his wife, Maxine, of the home; two daughters, Diane Brasell and her husband Bert of Bartlett, Tennessee and Judy Coon and her husband Billy of Memphis, Tennessee a son, Gary Lendermon and his wife, Martha of Collierville, Tennessee; three sisters, Pat Cole, Ernestine Cravens and Dora Lee Wells; five brothers, Robert Hugh, Fyed, L. D., Russell, and Doug; two step sisters, Geraldine Speight and Wanda Rosel; seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. He is preceded in death by two

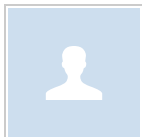
“ *Maxine and Children,
