William Kay Moser, 88, of Searcy, Arkansas, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, August 4, 2018, near 4:00 AM, at home with his family. He was born near Wiseman, Arkansas, on December 18, 1929, to the late William Noel and Lois LaNelle Moser. He was a published author of 3 novels (Thorn in the Flesh, A Beautiful Fascination, A Glorious Summer) and 1 autobiography (Be a Man, Son). Mr. Moser was a lifetime contributor of articles to Christian publications and local newspapers.
