Wilton "Dean" Poole, 72, was born in White County, Arkansas to Wilton and Mattie (Hall) Poole on October 2, 1939. He passed from this life on June 12, 2012. Dean was a lifelong member of the Church of Christ and a conservative Democrat in his beliefs. He served as an elder in the Church of Christ for over 20 years. He was a farmer, and owned Poole's Styling Center and was a well known barber for 45 years. He served in the Searcy Unit of the Arkansas National Guard. Dean rooted for the Razorback basketball, football and baseball teams. The Dallas Cowboys was a favorite; and had picked the Oklahoma City Thunder to win this year's NBA title. He was also a fan of the Dallas Mavericks and the Boston Celtics. He enjoyed watching golf and his favorites were Bubba and Tiger. In his younger years, Dean was a deer hunter, coon hunter, and liked fishing float trips down the Little Red River.
